TEXTreme Benchrest Events and Rules.

1. 100 yard Benchrest – (100Y BR)

-Any pellet gun up to .30 caliber may be used

- No solid slugs or cast bullets allowed (mass production diablo pellets only)
- No power restrictions
- No weight restrictions
- Target distance will be at 100 yards
- One piece rests are allowed
- Tethered tanks are not allowed
- Total air cylinder volume limited to 580cc
- Fill as many times needed during shooting relay. Note...for safety, rifles may not leave bench during a relay
- MATCH FORMAT
- 12 targets per shooter, three shots upper left, two shots remainder. EBR size 7 to X ring.
- 6 sighter targets below score targets.
- 30 minute time limit – includes sight in.
- 4 shooters per relay
- All scorecards will be plugged equally
- Sight in time will be a part of 30 minute relay
- Best score for each relay will advance to the Finals. In the event we have 12 or less competitors the best score plus the best non relay winner score will advance.

- SCORING

- Targets will be inward scoring with 0.30 scoring plug
 - Anything outside of the target rings will be scored a 6
 - Any additional competitive shots over 25 will have a 10 point penalty per shot
 - Maximum score of 250 with twenty five 10X
 - Shooting the wrong target card/lane is an automatic disqualification
 - Disputes: Shooters may dispute a score or shot, but entire card will be checked.

2. 50 Yard Benchrest (50Y BR)

Unlimited Class

- (USARB Class, pellets only, no slugs)
- Calibers allowed: .177, .20, and .22.
- Any power level is allowed
- Any weight rifle is allowed
- Rifles using electrically actuated or powered components, or computer processors and applications are allowed.
- Wind flags or anemometers sensing and transmitting data to a computer device or display are allowed.
- Front rests using electrically actuated or powered components are allowed.
- One piece rests are allowed.
- Scopes transmitting or receiving data from a computer device are allowed.
- Scopes may utilize illumination.
- Tethered tanks are not allowed.
- International scoring rules will apply.
- Target distance: 50 yards
- Best score for each relay will advance to the Finals. In the event we have 12 or less competitors the best score plus the best non relay winner score will advance.

- TARGETS:

- 50 Yard Benchrest Target Standard USARB 50Y target
- There will be TWO, not THREE cards shot in qualification round.
- There will be ONE card shot in Finals round

- 20 minutes per card with 10 minute break between cards for filling guns. Guns MAY NOT be filled during the 20 minute shooting time per card.
 - Maximum score is 500 – 50X.
 - Cards will be scored with 0.224” scoring plug.
 - Disputes: Shooters may dispute a score or shot, but entire card will be checked.

3. Benchrest Silhouette (BRS)

- All shooting is from supplied shooting benches.
- Wind flags are allowed.
- Spotting scopes, spotters, and coaching are allowed.
- A sandbag or bipod is allowed under the fore-end or front rail.
- Only shooters’ off hand is allowed under the rifle butt.
- No umbilical or remote-control triggers are allowed.
- No slugs
- 80 FPE maximum power level
- Targets are 1/10 scale airgun silhouette swingers.
- Matches are forty shots - ten shots each at the 40 yard chicken, 60 yard pig, 77 yard turkey, and 100 yard ram.
- Steel back-stops behind the silhouettes show your misses.

At a start signal, shooters have 10 minutes for unlimited sighting shots at the backstop, AND THEN ten shots at the animal target for record. Once shooting for score, NO MORE sighters are allowed.

4. Speed Know Your Limits (S-KYL)

- KYL Swingers will be shot in a man against man format. Positions will be drawn from a hat for both 25M and 50Y shoot-offs.
- KYL Swingers will be at 25 meters and 50 yards.
- A sandbag or bipod is allowed under the fore-end or front rail.
- Only shooters’ off hand is allowed under the rifle butt.
- Pellets only. No slugs
- Semi-automatic guns NOT allowed.
- Magazines are limited to 9 pellets per magazine, maximum of .30 caliber. No slugs.
- Shooters will shoot the 8 KYL swingers at 50 yards in a ladder format until winner.
- Shooters will then shoot the 8 KYL swingers at 25 meters in a ladder format until winner.
- In each match, after KYL is cleared, the shooter must shoot the stop plate.

- First shooter to hit all KYL swingers and the stop plate wins the duel and advances.
 - The Winner at 50Y and the Winner at 25M will shoot for first place. Prior to the FINAL, the runners up at 25M and 50Y will shoot for third place.
 - The final will be BOTH 50Y and 25M in series, however the smallest swinger will be removed, so only 7 swingers per set, total of 14 targets plus the stop plate. Same 9 pellets per magazine rule.
 - These two FINALS matches will require a forced magazine change. Also, for qualification matches at 25M and 50Y, a miss will require a magazine change.
